ALICE STYLE

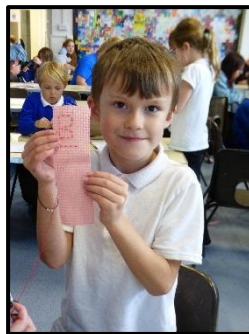
