Year 3	<p align="center"><b><u>Fossils and Ammonite</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Printing</b></p> <p>Using ammonite fossils as inspiration, pupils experience observing the different patterns they can see in them as inspiration for their own collograph, relief and mono print.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Prehistoric Pots</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –3D Medium</b></p> <p>Year 3 will begin exploring 3D form by creating their own Prehistoric Pots. Using Paper Mache, pupils will design and make their own pots inspired by the Beaker People.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Scarab Beetles</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Drawing and Painting</b></p> <p>Pupils will begin developing their application of paint to paper. They will use artist Tracy English as inspiration to create their own Scarab Beetle inspired artwork.</p>
Year 4	<p align="center"><b><u>Clay Pots</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –3D Medium</b></p> <p>In Year 4, pupils will develop their skills in creating 3D form. They will use clay to create Celtic inspired pots and use different materials to create the authentic details.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Starlings</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Printing</b></p> <p>Pupils will create their own printing material to print their own starling inspired pictures.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Anglo Saxon Broaches</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Drawing and Painting</b></p> <p>Pupils will observe and sketch Anglo Saxon Broaches alongside their study of the Anglo Saxons.</p>
Year 5	<p align="center"><b><u>3D Tudor Portraits</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –3D Medium</b></p> <p>Through their study of the Tudors, Year 5 will create their own 3D Tudor portraits using a range of textiles and 3D elements.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Space</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Drawing and Painting</b></p> <p>Taking inspiration from space, pupils will develop their understanding of line and colour. Taking inspiration from artist Kandinsky, pupils will create their own Kandinsky inspired space pictures.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Geometric Art</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Printing</b></p> <p>Pupils will create their own block printing designs and print onto fabric. Pupils will take inspiration from different cultures and explore these within this topic.</p>
Year 6	<p align="center"><b><u>William Morris</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Printing</b></p> <p>Pupils will look at Artist William Morris and produce their own William Morris inspired print work. They will develop their skills in observing and sketching as they look at a range of work by this famous artist.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Landscapes</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –Drawing and Painting</b></p> <p>Pupils will look at some of the fundamentals of drawing and painting. They will explore a range of landscape artists with contrasting styles and techniques.</p>	<p align="center"><b><u>Production Masks</u></b>  <b>Art Skill –3D Medium</b></p> <p>As part of their final school production, pupils will develop and design their own props/masks for their school production.</p>
